



South Mountain Defense
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Defensive Shotgun (Level 2)

A one-day course dealing with the PRACTICAL application and use of the slide action (pump) and semi-automatic shotgun. The course looks at various shooting positions, techniques, and decision-making considerations when employing the shotgun as a defensive tool. **It is NOT REQUIRED that Level 1 was taken.** This course is a pure application of shooter and firearms in practical applications..

Students To Bring:

- Shotgun (rentals available at an additional cost for ammunition only).
- Sling is highly recommended but not required.
- One hundred (100) rounds of #7 ½ or #8 birdshot.
- Fifty (50) rounds of OO or #4 buckshot .
- Fifteen (15) rounds of rifled or sabot slugs.
****Note: Please be sure your shotgun can safely shoot slugs. Contact us if unsure.**
- Home / carry handgun and one hundred rounds (100) of ammunition.
- Sturdy hip (OWB style preferred but not required) holster.
- Please bring your own eye and hearing protection.
- Notebook.
